I. ADMISSION CRITERIA

Applicant must:

1. be a Nigerian citizen.
2. be between 16 years and 18 years old.
3. be in first year of academic studies in an accredited tertiary institution in Nigeria.
4. have the aspiration and potential to become a high profile leader.
5. have the desire to fight corruption and the courage to resist it.
6. have the passion for public service.
7. be willing to travel within and outside the country for trainings.
8. be intelligent, creative and law abiding.

II. APPLICATION PROCESS

1. Write NOT MORE THAN 800-word essay on “WHAT I CAN DO FOR MY COUNTRY, NIGERIA”
2. At the beginning of the essay, provide the following information about yourself:
 - a. Full name in the following order: (Last name, middle name, first name)
 - b. Date of Birth
 - c. Town, LGA and State of Origin.
 - d. Name of institution, faculty and department
 - e. Your email address and phone number.
 - f. Name, email address and phone number of a referee (*Referee MUST be your Religious Leader, Traditional Ruler or Lecturer*)
 - g. Names and phone numbers of your parents or guardian.
